We enjoy a challenge and ways to experience 'doing and being' Christians.

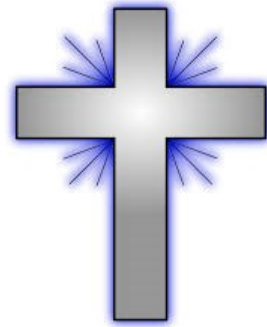
EvnU believes we are all Gods children and He wants us in his family.
